"Social and Economic Empowerment of Migrant Women" - WINGS

Rationale: It goes without saying that migrant women are among the most vulnerable social groups in a society due to their double identity as both migrants and women. The aim of the WINGS project is that migrant women currently without basic skills and outside of mainstream lifelong learning provision are supported to integrate into their local community economically and socially. Through this training migrant women on the margins of education and training are encouraged to embark on an educational journey towards employment and labour market integration.
