

## **UPCOMING MILESTONES**

Looking ahead, we have two exciting milestones in the next six month period. First, our Irish partners organise a 5-day workshop in July 2023 in Virginia with one senior and one digital native from each partner country. The plan is to form inter-generational, intercultural teams and to facilitate discussion and active working sessions to brainstorm and assess the low-tech and high-tech solutions that have been developed in each partner country. Secondly, partners will implement the training and a minimum of 8 adult educators will complete the in-service training in each partner country.
